HOUSE CHURCH DISCUSSION GUIDE

Key Scripture:
Exodus 8:8-16

BIG IDEA

How we fight our battles with the people in our closest quarters will set the trajectory for how they fight their battles long after us.

KEY QUESTIONS

1. Can you think of a story or a moment in your own life where you felt held up by someone else? What was that like?
2. What kinds of battles have you faced that you felt like you had no control over? How did you handle them?
3. Read Exodus 8:8-16. What surprises you about the story of Moses, Joshua, and this battle with the Amalekites?
4. Have you ever had a moment where someone you admired saw some potential in you that you never would have seen? How did you respond?
5. What does it mean for you to hear, "There's a tomorrow in your future"? How does that provide hope?
6. How might you need to stop seeing those in your closest quarters as the enemy? What does it mean to be back on the same team?
7. What might "fighting by surrendering" mean for you right now?
